R/N Search

Key role in NNSA's counterterrorism response mission.

- PRND Major events
- RNSO assist State LEO in locating lost or stolen radioactive/nuclear materials



Regional Preparedness

- Train partners on RN search techniques
- Participate in drills and exercises
- Conduct outreach events

Consequence Management

Activities occurring after a known or suspected release of radioactive materials.

- Characterize radiological consequences.
- Advise decision-makers on public health actions.



Typical RAP Team

- 1 Federal Team Leader (FTL)
- 1 Team Captain (TC)
- 1 Team Scientist (TS)
- 2 Health Physics Support Personnel (HPSP)
- One or more vehicles with equipment


Rap must be mobilized and ready to deploy:
